Oh, the Places You Will Go With Dr. Seuss

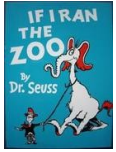

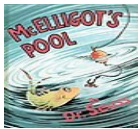
2018 Camp Themes



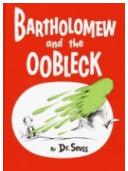
Week 1 June 25- June 29 “If I Ran the Zoo”

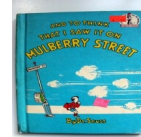
Week 5 July 23 – July 27 “The Grinch”
