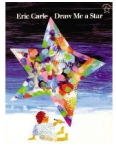
2019 Camp Themes

We will join a young artist in this story as he creates a world through paints. A local artist will join us this week to guide us in our own creation project. Obviously, our Creation Bible story will continue this week.

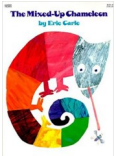

Week 7 August 5 - 9 "The Honeybee and the Robber"



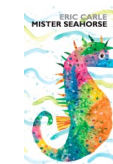
